

CONSEQUENCES OF FALSE POSITIVES



Have you ever looked for an email you were sent, but you couldn't find it until you finally checked your spam folder?

THAT IS A FALSE POSITIVE.

We call it that because your email's spam filter flagged the email as spam, even though the email wasn't spam.

WHY DO FALSE POSITIVES HAPPEN?

Content filters cause many false positives. This is a method of filtering spam emails that looks at the content of an email to guess if the email is spam or not.

Content filters fail if someone sends you an email with the wrong combination of words—even if it is an important email from a trusted source—it could get flagged as spam!
